





Our membership has been growing




We are doing better than most of the other clubs* in our district




But a lot of churning is taking place



About half the attrition is unavoidable




We are doing well on gender but not so on age and ethnicity




How we compare with other clubs

Percentage Female




Some of the large clubs are struggling to keep attendance up

Process is simple

- 1. Bring candidate as a guest 3 times
- 2. Candidate fills application on LARC website
- 3. Sponsor fills application
- 4. Applications automatically come to me (Membership Director)
- 5. MD gets board approval and notifies club members
- 6. One hour orientation is held
- 7. Induction as a Red Badger
